Representative Kane secures increased road and bridge funding for Shrewsbury and Westborough

Ensuring \$992,496 in funds for Shrewsbury and \$790,190 in funding for the town of Westborough

BOSTON – State Representative **Hannah E. Kane (R-Shrewsbury)**, is pleased to announce that the Town of Shrewsbury will receive \$992,496 and the Town of Westborough will receive \$790,190 for local road and bridge repairs. The funding was included as part of a \$200 million Chapter 90 bond authorization approved by the House of Representatives on March 30th.

"This is great news for both of the communities that I have the honor of representing as it means additional funding will soon be available to address the infrastructure needs of Shrewsbury and Westborough in time for the 2016 construction season," said Representative Kane.

Chapter 90 funds can be spent on a variety of municipal roadway projects, including resurfacing, drainage, sidewalks, traffic control and street lighting. The funding can also be used for bikeways, landscaping and tree planting, and for certain road building machinery, equipment and tools.

Established in 1973, the state's Chapter 90 program allocates funding to cities and towns using a formula based on the weighted average of a municipality's population, employment, and total road miles. The funds are paid out as reimbursements to communities for qualifying infrastructure work.

The bill now heads to the Senate for further action.
