Shrewsbury High School Boys Hockey Team Honored At State House

Players tour building, meet with legislators to celebrate state championship

BOSTON – Senator Michael O. Moore (D-Millbury) and Representative Hannah E. Kane (R-Shrewsbury) welcomed more than two dozen Shrewsbury High School Boys Hockey Team players and athletic staff to the State House to celebrate the team's recent MIAA Division 3 state hockey championship victory.
