Representative Kane Welcomes New Legislative Aide to Team at State House

Boston – State Representative Hannah E. Kane (R-Shrewsbury) has hired Anna Darrow, recent college graduate, as her new Legislative Aide at the State House.

Anna was born and raised in Burlington, Vermont and graduated from Trinity College (Hartford) in May 2019. At Trinity, she majored in Political Science and was a founding member of Alpha Chi Omega Sorority, which raised awareness on campus and worked with local women's shelters in Hartford to address domestic violence and aide in its prevention.

As a Political Science major, Anna interned at the Connecticut State House her junior and senior years of college, working for a state senator as well as a lobbying firm to gain insight into the legislative and political processes. She researched legislation, attended committee meetings and public hearings, and worked to solve constituent issues. Her internships in Hartford, as well as a summer internship at the Massachusetts State House following graduation, inspired Anna to work as a Legislative Aide for Representative Kane.

Anna has always been interested in pursuing a career in public service and government. As the descendant of a 100-year old family run orchard in Vermont, she is personally aware of the problems small farms face and is looking forward to working closely with the Food System Caucus, which Rep Kane founded last year. She is also excited to start her career in Boston, where her parents met as young professionals.
